Installation: Slip-fitter Mounting

This fixture can be mounted to an existing 2.375OD Tenon, Bullhorn or mounting on the optional slip-fitter adaptor.

Read page one of this instruction guide before proceeding.

1. Remove pole cap and disconnect power wires to existing fixture, then remove fixture.

2. Feed wiring from new ST series fixtures slip-fitter to inside of mounting pole and push new fixture slip-fitter onto Tenon. **See figure 1.**

3. Tighten slip-fitter onto Tenon using the included hardware, make sure all bolts are secure. See figure 2.

4. This fixture can be configured to provide 0 to 60° both upward and downward aiming, adjust as needed by loosing bolt and then retightening once right angle is achieved.

5. Make electrical connections in pole. Once complete test lights operation, Light comes with a shorting cap.
